Personal criteria to be considered:

- •Some good sobriety.
- •Personal experience of alcoholism and 12 step recovery.
- •A common sense approach
- •A commitment to carrying the message inside a correctional centre.
- •The ability to follow directions and to work with the staff of correctional facilities. (*Remember our presence in the facility starts with the permission and cooperation of the officials in that facility*).

To be allowed into a correctional facility, you are required to complete official forms and submit them through the current AA Woodford Coordinator for Area B.

- As well as the form nominated above, please include a colour copy of your drivers licence (both front and back).

Once the completed forms have been accepted and approved, a Custodial Awareness Induction will be organised between the Correctional Centre and the Woodford AA coordinator
